


Autograding software

Student view

Ensure that students are seeing the updated version of the software, as it's the updated version which sends the results through to the teacher's management system.

The updated version displays '**Autograded translation**' in the top orange bar, and '**Question x of y**' directly below the orange bar:


If the students are not seeing this latest version, ask them to force-refresh the page (Shift-refresh) a few times.

Step 1: Click the 'Manage' button (top right on orange bar)


Step 2: Click 'View autograded translations for a class':

Step 4: The students' results are displayed:

Select a result to see the exercise in detail.
Click the column headers to sort the table up and down.

In the top (dark grey) bar, the number of the activity is shown. For example '1-1' means Chapter 1, activity 1; '1-2' means Chapter 1, activity 2; and so on. An activity number/column is shown only if at least one student in the class has attempted it.

The grades (e.g. '79', '96', '83') are computer generated scores out of 100 for the accuracy of the students' translations across the exercise as a whole. We're looking at various options for the scores, but they should give a pretty good overall view of how the students are getting on.

Step 5: Click on a student's score:

This will show you the date and time when the student completed the exercise, the student's overall score, his/her translations, and how they were corrected:
